SUMMER WAS SUMMER IN THE SUMMER IN THE SOUTH OF MESOPOTĀO © MIA (part of modern Iraq) perhaps the 4th millennium BC to about 2,000 BC, when it was replaced by Akkadian as a spoken language, although continued to be used in writing for religious, articles and academic purposes until about the Século I AD. SUMMER is not related to any other known language so it is classified as an insulation of language. Cuneiform Sumatic Cuneiform Sumatic is the oldest known writing system. Its origins can be traced up to about 8,000 BC and developed from the pictographs and other symbols used to represent commercial and animal goods on clay plates. Originally the sum made small clay symbols to represent the items. The symbols were kept together in sealed clay envelopes, and to show what was inside the envelopes, they press the symbols to the clay abroad. Examples of clay symbols over time they realized that the symbols were not necessarily as they could make the symbols in the clay. They also developed a numerical system to represent multiple instances of the same symbol as they are just enrolled all. Symbols have become stylized over time and eventually evolved into a complete writing system. The oldest texts are from the cities of Uruk and Jamdat Nasr and date back at 3,300BC. The cuneiform name means "Cunha" and comes from the Latin Cuneu (Cunha). It is based on the appearance of the spills, which were made by pressing a clay tube. This type of symbol emerged at 3,000 BC. For about 2,800 BC some of the sumatic glyphs were being used to represent sounds using the principle of reprimand. For example, the pronounced "IT" symbol, was used to represent the word for life (TIL). There were many glyphs that were pronounced the same, but represented different words.
